Event Information Applicable to Both Events

Pre-Registration

- Pre-registration will take place at the Downtown Orlando YMCA on Friday, March 23, 2007 from 4:00 PM – 9:00 PM.
- Directions
 - DIRECTIONS FROM I-4 EAST (Daytona Beach) -Get off at Colonial Drive exit. Turn left onto Colonial Drive. Turn right onto Mills Ave. Downtown Orlando YMCA will be on left at the corner of Mills Ave and Amelia St.
 - DIRECTIONS FROM I-4 WEST (Tampa) - Get off at Amelia Street exit. Turn right onto Amelia St. Downtown Orlando YMCA will be at the corner of Amelia St. and Mills Ave.

Awards

- Saturday's Criterium is a Florida Cup Series Race.
- Sunday's Circuit Race is a Florida Points Series Race.

Awards Ceremony

- Location
 - All awards ceremonies will take place next to the start/finish stage at the start/finish line.
- Expectations for riders
 - The first, second and third place finishers of each event are expected to receive their awards at the conclusion of their race.
 - Listen for an announcement of your award ceremonies.
- Consequences
 - Failure to appear at the awards ceremony when announced will subject the rider to a \$50 fine taken from the winnings.
 - This applies to USPRO racers as well.

Registration

- Entry fees paid after March 19, 2007 are \$35 for all USCF categories and \$45 for Pro, 1, 2. Second events in the same day are \$15. If you choose to race Pro, 1, 2 and any other category (except Junior), you will pay \$45 for the Pro, 1, 2 entry and \$15 for the other entry. ALL pre-registered riders failing to pay the appropriate entry fee will not be allowed to race.
- The entry fee for all Juniors categories is \$FREE. This entry fee does not count as a first event for other races and does not make Junior category racers eligible for second and third race discounts. Juniors can compete in other categories but must pay the initial USCF entry fee before qualifying for second and third race discounts.

USCF Races

- Registration closes promptly 30 minutes prior to the start of each event.
- Wheels in / wheels out will be strictly enforced – don't try to take wheels out of the pit if you didn't put any wheels in.
- To reclaim your wheels once they're in the pit, you must show your number to the pit attendant.
- There is NO feed zone in any race.

Refunds

- No refunds- Racing rain or shine.
- Overpayment of entry fees will be refunded by check in the mail.

Downtown Orlando Criterium - Saturday, March 24, 2007

Parking

- Parking is available in both metered parking and a variety of parking garages/lots illustrated in the Downtown Orlando parking map below. **No** racer parking will be allowed within the race route – your car will be towed.
- No cars will be allowed within the race route after 1:00 p.m.

Registration

- Registration will take place at Slingapours at Wall Street Plaza.
- Registration closes promptly 30 minutes prior to start of each event.

Cash Payout - Saturday

- Pro, 1, 2 – cash is paid to the top 25 placed riders according to the following schedule: \$1,300, \$650, \$435, \$325, \$265, \$220, \$190, \$165, \$160, \$140, \$125, \$110, \$100, \$95, \$90, \$85, \$80, \$75, \$70, \$65, \$60, \$55, \$50, \$45, \$45
- Category 3 - cash is paid to the top 20 placed riders according to the following schedule: \$160, \$140, \$130, \$120, \$110, \$100, \$90, \$85, \$80, \$75, \$65, \$60, \$55, \$50, \$45, \$40, \$35, \$25, \$20, \$15
- Masters 35+ – cash is paid to the top 12 placed riders according to the following schedule: \$150, \$130, \$110, \$90, \$75, \$60, \$45, \$40, \$35, \$30, \$25, \$20
- Women 1, 2, 3 - cash is paid to the top 8 placed riders according to the following schedule: \$130, \$90, \$75, \$60, \$50, \$40, \$30, \$25
- Masters 45 and Category 4 – cash is paid to the top 10 placed riders according to the following schedule: \$125, \$80, \$70, \$45, \$40, \$35, \$30, \$25, \$25, \$25
- Masters 55+ - cash is paid to the top 6 placed riders according to the following schedule: \$90, \$70, \$50, \$35, \$30, \$25
- Women's Category 4 – cash is paid to the top 5 placed riders according to the following schedule: \$60, \$50, \$40, \$30, \$20

Cash Payout- Sunday

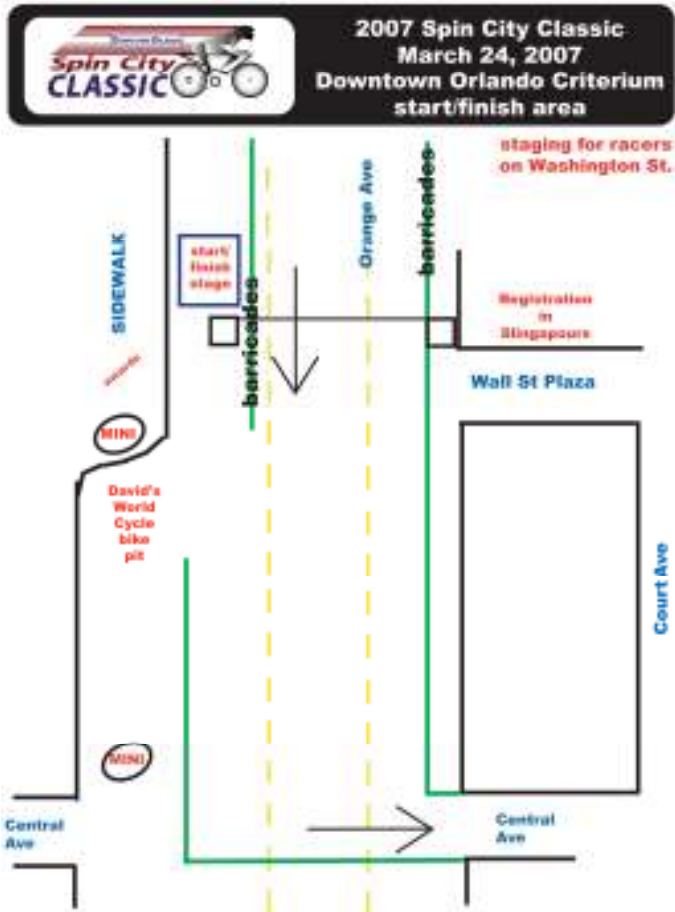
